Through Foodbank Fundamentals, we've helped projects provide essential food supplies, improve storage and distribution facilities, and create welcoming spaces where people can access support with dignity.

Through this fund, we awarded **£400,200 to 652 groups**, each working tirelessly to make sure no one goes hungry. From providing food and hygiene supplies, upgrading food storage and refrigeration to expanding volunteer capacity and improving accessibility, the range of projects funded has been both practical and transformative.

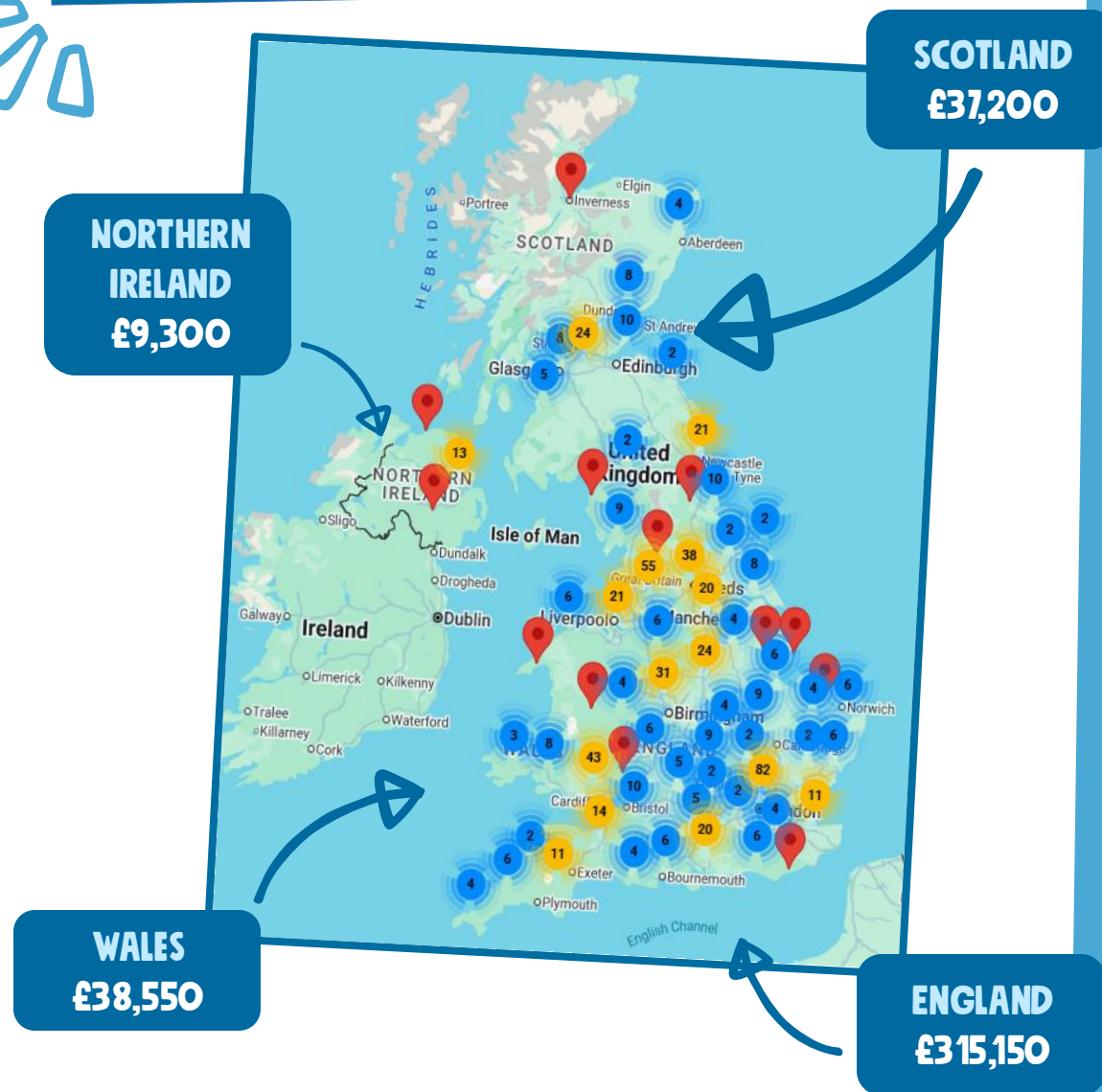

LINCOLN COMMUNITY LARDER

LINCOLN, ENGLAND

Lincoln Community Larder supports local people facing food insecurity by providing affordable, nutritious food and promoting dignity and choice.

Community Larder clients are referred by agencies or self referral, receiving pre-packed bags with three days' worth of food, plus extras for families with children. For those without cooking facilities, suitable options like self-heating meals are provided.

Our funding enabled this group to deliver a 16-week winter campaign for rough sleepers, providing smaller, targeted food packs during the harshest months.

This project ensures some of the most vulnerable members of the community receive essential care and support when they need it most.

Foodstock started as a foodbank in 2019 and has operated from its current site since 2021. It provides emergency food parcels to individuals and families in crisis, accessed through referrals from partners such as GP surgeries, schools, advice centres, and charities.

Each parcel includes four meals, snacks, fresh produce, and items tailored to dietary and cultural needs, reflecting Foodstock's commitment to dignity and inclusivity.

Our funding will help Foodstock continue tackling food insecurity through a compassionate, community-led model. The grant will fund essential food supplies for those in crisis, delivered directly to their homes after referral, meeting immediate needs while fostering care and solidarity locally



Thanks to this funding, we can continue delivering emergency food parcels directly to those most in need, ensuring meals are tailored to dietary and cultural requirements. This support helps us meet urgent nutritional needs while strengthening our community-led approach to tackling food insecurity.

CREDITON FOODBANK

DEVON, ENGLAND

Crediton Foodbank is a registered charity providing emergency food assistance to individuals and families facing hardship across Crediton and surrounding villages.

Their work ensures that no one goes hungry during times of crisis, such as job loss, benefit delays, or unexpected bills. Alongside food support, they offer financial advice, referrals to other agencies, and help for children receiving Free School Meals. Committed to confidentiality, compassion, and accountability, the charity plays a vital role in fostering resilience and hope within the local community.

Our funding will help this amazing group to transform their long-standing storage space, which had not been updated since 2011, creating a more hospitable and functional environment for all. They will replace worn flooring, repaint, and install sloping shelves with containers, making food items easier to access and remove an old cupboard to increase floor and shelving space. Any remaining funds will be used to purchase essential food supplies, helping the foodbank continue its vital work.

CANALSIDE COMMUNITY FRIDGE

WOKING, ENGLAND

Canalside Community Fridge in Woking began in 2022 with operations limited to Mondays. In December 2023, they expanded their reach through a partnership with Shifa, a local charity dedicated to empowering women with English as an additional language. Shifa now manages the fridge on Wednesdays, enhancing accessibility and community engagement. Visitors often come to the fridge through informal referrals from local organisations, ensuring that the fridge reaches those most in need.

Our funding has enabled the purchase of a new energy-efficient refrigerator wall cabinet with a night shutter. Their previous unit was outdated and highly inefficient, incurring running costs of over £2,000 annually and conflicting with environmental sustainability goals.

The new fridge will help preserve the quality of surplus food collected, regular deliveries from FareShare, and donations, including produce from local gardens and allotments. As of May 2024, this amazing group had successfully redistributed over 20 tonnes of surplus food, significantly reducing waste and supporting food security.

LOCAL STORE: ASDA WOKING SHEERWATER

COLDSTREAM COMMUNITY LARDER

SCOTTISH BORDERS, SCOTLAND

Coldstream Community Larder was created to tackle high local demand for food support and reduce waste through its 'Feed Bellies Not Bins' ethos. Based in the Scottish Borders, the group provides a welcoming space where people can access essential items without stigma. Alongside food, they work hard to supply toiletries and cleaning products, items that are rarely donated but make a huge difference to families struggling financially.

With their Foodbank Fundamentals grant, the larder will purchase basic hygiene essentials such as deodorant, shampoo, shower gel, toothbrushes, toothpaste, washing powder, and household cleaners. These products will be available free of charge during two weekly sessions, helping around 50 people each week to maintain dignity and wellbeing.

This support will ease financial pressure for local families, allowing them to redirect limited income to other essentials. By removing barriers and offering practical help, the larder strengthens community resilience, encourages recycling, and fosters a sense of belonging – creating positive change for those most in need.

LEVENMOUTH FOODBANK COMMUNITY SUPPORT

METHIL, SCOTLAND

Levenmouth Foodbank supports households in crisis across the Levenmouth community, providing emergency food parcels alongside a free café service that combats isolation and promotes connection. Referrals come through local agencies, ensuring those most in need receive practical help and signposting to wider support.

Our funding enabled the foodbank to purchase essential hygiene items, such as nappies, toiletries, and cleaning products – to include within its three-day emergency parcels. These items are often overlooked and donated less but make a huge difference, helping families maintain dignity and wellbeing during difficult times.

By meeting these basic needs, the foodbank reduces stress for those facing impossible choices and strengthens its role as a lifeline in one of Scotland's most deprived areas.

MAMACITA FOUNDATION

ABERDEEN, SCOTLAND

Based in Aberdeen, Mamacita Foundation provides essential support to low-income families and refugees. Their emergency foodbank and doorstep delivery service ensure that those unable to attend in person, such as the elderly, disabled, and single parents, receive vital help.

With our Foodbank Fundamentals grant, the group has been able to cover fuel costs for volunteer drivers who go above and beyond to deliver food and hygiene essentials directly to doorsteps. This support not only keeps the wheels turning but also recognises the dedication of volunteers who often use their own resources to help others.

By easing this burden, the grant allows Mamacita Foundation to reach more people, reduce isolation, and provide dignity and care where it's needed most. Together, we're helping build a stronger, more compassionate Aberdeen.

MERTHYR CYNON FOODBANK

MERTHYR TYDFIL, WALES

Serving some of the most deprived communities in Wales, Merthyr Cynon Foodbank operates eight distribution centres across Merthyr Tydfil and Cynon Valley. Last year, they supported nearly 7,000 people in crisis, and demand continues to rise.

With our funding, the foodbank can include essential toiletries alongside food parcels, helping families maintain dignity and basic hygiene during hardship. Items such as soap, shampoo, and sanitary products are vital for health and wellbeing.

The grant also covers fuel costs, enabling volunteers to deliver supplies to centres and reach those unable to travel. This support is critical in rural areas where transport barriers often leave people isolated. With 60 dedicated volunteers, the foodbank works tirelessly to ensure no one goes without essentials. By funding hygiene products and the logistics behind distribution, we're helping the team respond quickly and effectively to local need, easing pressure on households and strengthening community resilience.

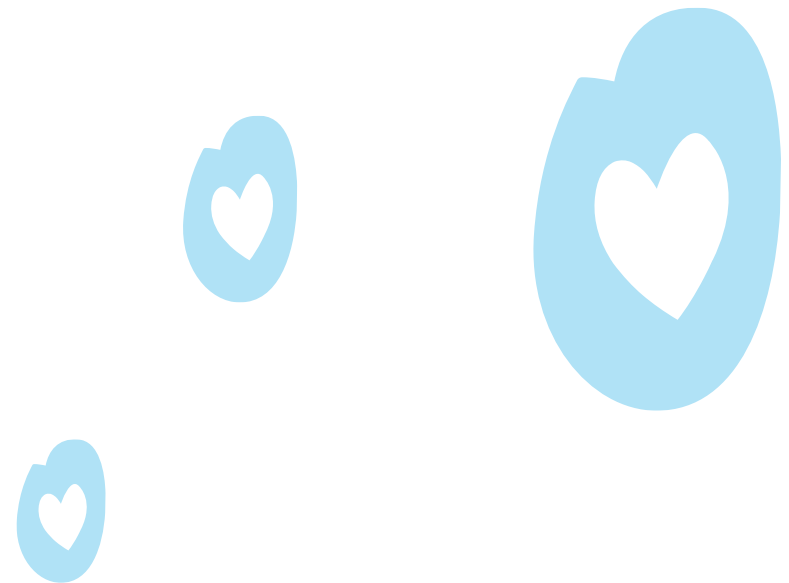
