## MESSAGE FROM OUR CHAIR OF TRUSTEES

We're proud to share this year's Funding in Action Report, highlighting the impact of our Young Futures Fund and the difference it continues to make for children and young people in our communities.

Findings from our Community Insight Tracker surveys showed a clear need for targeted support, from mental health and wellbeing for teenagers to help for families during school holidays and opportunities for younger children to lead active lives. In response, we refreshed our Young Futures Fund to better reflect these needs and ensure our funding is shaped by community feedback.

This year, the fund was delivered through three focused funds. The Healthy Teen Minds Fund supported improved mental health and wellbeing for young people aged 13–18. The Active Young Lives Fund helped primary school age children to be active by funding sports kit and equipment. The School Holiday Essentials Fund supported primary school age children during the school holidays by helping holiday clubs provide food, essential hygiene items, and activities.

In total, through the Young Futures Fund this year, we awarded £772,814 to 986 groups. We're incredibly grateful to the organisations and individuals delivering this work with such care, creativity and commitment. As needs continue to evolve, we remain committed to listening, learning and responding to community needs, so that children and young people have the best possible start and support.

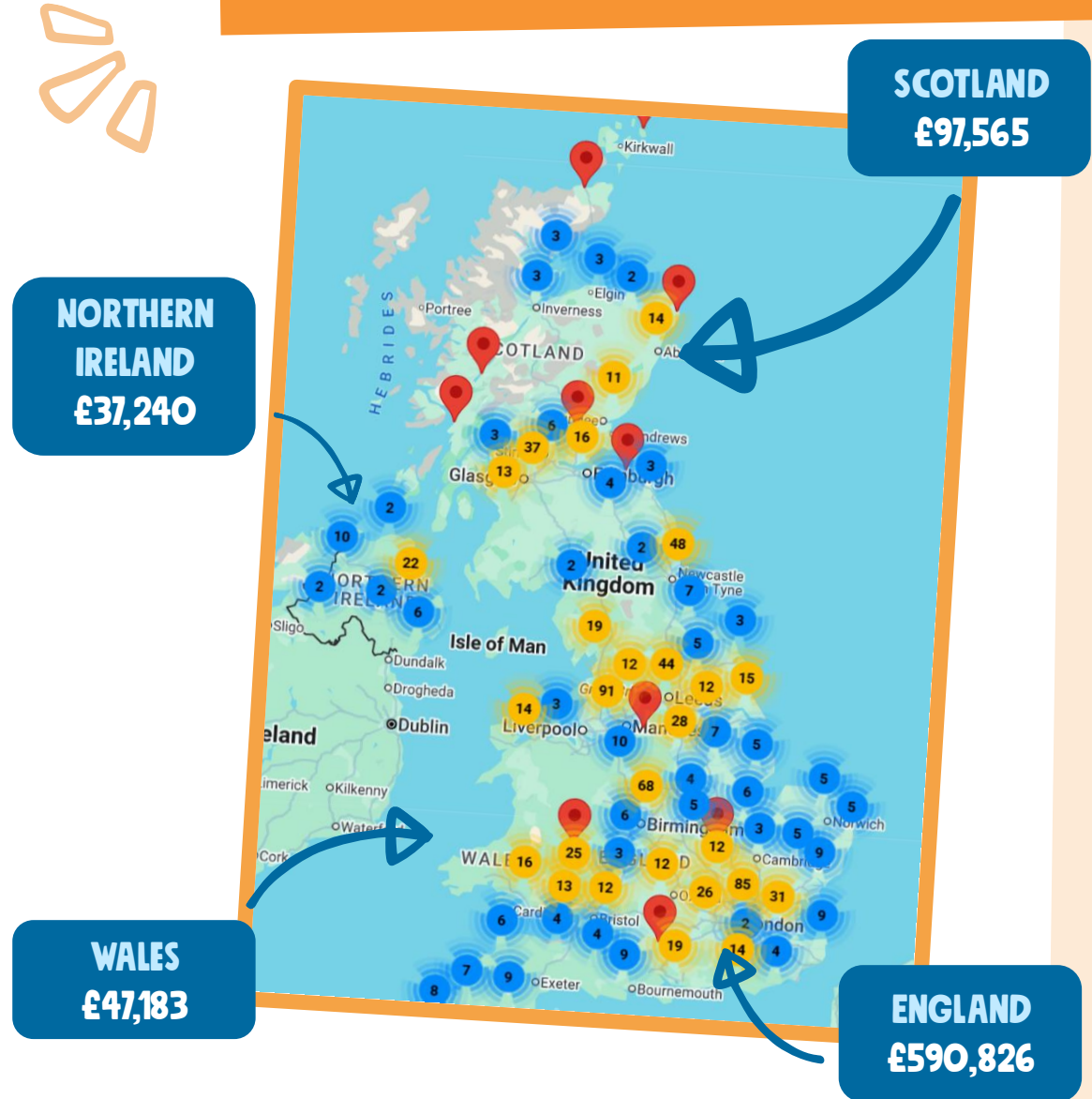

# LINK BEFRIENDING ADOLESCENT PROJECT

FIFE, SCOTLAND

LINK Adolescent Befriending Project provides vital one-to-one befriending support for young people aged 12-18 who are isolated due to mental health challenges. Their project offers a lifeline to young people facing anxiety, depression, trauma, neurodivergence, family difficulties and multiple complex pressures.

Befriending sessions take place out in the community, beginning with confidence-building activities like short walks, a drink at the park or time spent outdoors, often the first steps outside the home in weeks or months for some young people. As trust grows, these meetings progress to more engaging activities such as swimming, bowling, art classes or cycling, helping young people build resilience, social skills, and hope for their future. LINK also brings young people together at supported group events throughout the year, helping them feel connected, accepted and less alone.

Our funding will enable LINK to continue supporting adolescents experiencing severe isolation, loneliness, and mental health distress, ensuring they can access activities, services and opportunities that would otherwise be out of reach. Through this project, young people gain confidence, improve wellbeing, and receive the support they need to re-engage with education, friendships and their wider community.

# KINGDOM YOUTH CLUB

KILKEEL, NORTHERN IRELAND

Kingdom Youth Club offer a safe, youth-led space where young people shape activities, build confidence and take part in meaningful programmes ranging from mental health and wellbeing support to life skills, employability, and volunteering.

Our funding is helping Kingdom Youth Club work directly with a group of young people experiencing financial hardship, ensuring they have access to essential food and hygiene items. Through budget-friendly cooking classes, participants learn how to prepare healthy meals and take ingredients home using provided storage containers. The project also supplies hygiene and period product packs, alongside practical training such as barista skills, first aid and Take 5 wellbeing workshops.

By combining essential provisions with hands-on learning, this project supports young people who are struggling with education, training, and the rising cost of living. It offers a warm, supportive environment where they can build confidence, develop life skills and take positive steps towards future opportunities.

# THE JUNO PROJECT

SUSSEX, ENGLAND



The Juno Project supports girls and young women aged 10–16 across West Sussex through strengths-based wellbeing coaching delivered in schools and community settings. Many of the young women they work with face multiple adversities, such as domestic abuse, poor mental health, poverty, and disrupted education.

Our funding enabled The Juno Project to deliver a 12-week community wellbeing group for young women aged 13 and over, led by experienced facilitators with lived experience of overcoming their own challenges. In these warm, reflective sessions, participants explore topics such as self-esteem, body image, confidence, healthy relationships, staying safe online and managing anxiety. The group also supports young women to understand their values, build emotional regulation skills and set positive life and education goals.

This project helps young women improve their wellbeing, strengthen their sense of identity and purpose, and feel more connected to their peers and community, creating a foundation for healthier futures.

# WALAALO FC

LONDON, ENGLAND

Walaalo FC offers a safe, supportive space where young people can stay active, build confidence, and strengthen their wellbeing through football and structured development sessions. The club helps reduce isolation and encourages positive habits, particularly for teens navigating increasing pressures around mental health.

Our Young Futures funding is supporting Walaalo FC to deliver a targeted mental health and substance awareness project for 14 to 20-year-olds. This funding has enabled the group to bring in a medically trained specialist to run honest, age-appropriate sessions on the impact of substances and how they relate to emotional health. These workshops provide a safe space for open discussion, practical coping strategies, and signposting to support.

By raising awareness of key issues and providing meaningful early intervention, this project is helping young people make informed decisions, build resilience, and feel better equipped to look after their wellbeing.

# COMMUNITY ON SOLID GROUND

Community on Solid Ground provide a safe, inclusive space for young people considered high risk, helping them build confidence, resilience, and positive futures.

Their Saturday Youth Club offers a welcoming environment where teenagers can connect with peers, access mental health and wellbeing support, and take part in structured activities that build social skills and encourage physical health.

Our funding enabled the group to increase attendance while updating activities and equipment. This has helped ensure sessions remain inclusive, engaging, and responsive to the varied needs of participants.

By strengthening this well-established youth club, the project supports young people to build friendships, develop skills, and form positive connections within their community, while providing vital support at a crucial stage of their lives.

# RANDALSTOWN LADIES HOCKEY CLUB

ANTRIM, NORTHERN IRELAND

Randalstown Ladies Hockey Club encourages girls aged four upwards to get active and enjoy field hockey in a safe, welcoming environment. Based in the local community, the club offers both competitive and non-competitive opportunities, helping young players build confidence, teamwork and a love of sport from an early age.

With the help of our Young Futures Fund, the club was able to invest in essential shared equipment, including training bibs, new hockey balls, cones and markers, penalty masks, and goalkeeping aids. This has improved the quality, safety, and variety of training sessions for younger members.

Club-owned equipment helps ensure every child can participate fully, regardless of household circumstances. Our funding supports access to these shared resources, encouraging active lifestyles, skills development, and positive social connections. It also enables Randalstown Ladies Hockey Club to continue growing junior participation while promoting physical wellbeing, confidence, and a strong sense of belonging within the local community.

# DUNDEE CITY AQUATICS

DUNDEE, SCOTLAND

Dundee City Aquatics deliver 'Learn to Swim' programmes from early years through to competitive squads. A core part of their work is their Disability Learn to Swim programme, which provides specialist weekly sessions for children with physical, sensory and additional support needs, including those with life-shortening conditions.

Children attending these sessions often face barriers to accessing mainstream sport, and many families are unable to buy supportive swimming aids themselves. Dundee City Aquatics works to remove these obstacles by offering tailored, fully supported lessons in a safe and inclusive environment.

Our funding supported the purchase of essential kit and equipment, including flotation vests, kickboards, pool noodles and visual teaching aids. These resources help instructors adapt sessions to individual needs, improving safety, confidence and engagement in the water.

This project ensures disabled children in Dundee can enjoy the physical and emotional benefits of swimming, building confidence, skills and a lifelong connection to being active.

# RHYL HEARTS JUNIOR FOOTBALL CLUB

RHYL, WALES

Rhyl Hearts Junior Football Club are a volunteer-led grassroots club providing a safe, inclusive introduction to football for children aged 4–5 from Rhyl and the surrounding areas. The club welcomes girls and boys of all abilities, cultures, and backgrounds, creating a positive space where young children can play, make friends and build confidence through sport.

Through its Mini Kickers sessions, Rhyl Hearts supports children at the very start of their sporting journey, focusing on fun, teamwork, and basic football skills alongside important social development such as communication, friendship, and respect.

Our funding supported the purchase of training and match kits for the Mini Kickers as they prepare to move into competitive games. Having their own kit helps the children feel a strong sense of belonging and pride, strengthening team bonds and boosting confidence as they represent their club for the first time.

This project helps lay the foundations for children to lead active, positive young lives by giving children the opportunity to feel included, valued and proud to be part of a team.

# DERBY KIDS CAMP

DERBYSHIRE, ENGLAND

Derby Kids' Camp is a volunteer-run charity providing free residential holidays for children aged 8–11, who face a range of challenges, including financial hardship, bereavement, caring responsibilities and safeguarding concerns. Children are nominated by local primary schools, often because they would benefit most from time away, positive experiences and the chance to build confidence.

The camp offers a week of activities in a safe countryside setting, giving children opportunities to make friends, try new experiences and enjoy being active. Many attend for their first ever holiday or time away from home, helping them develop independence, resilience and social skills.

Our funding enabled Derby Kids' Camp to invest in new sports kit and equipment to strengthen their outdoor and team-based activities. The equipment supports inclusive games that encourage teamwork, communication and emotional regulation, helping children stay engaged, build confidence and improve their wellbeing while enjoying an active and memorable camp experience.

# ST STEPHEN'S NEIGHBOURHOOD CENTRE

St Stephen's Neighbourhood Centre provides a safe, welcoming space where children and families can feel supported and included. Through regular activities and close work with families, the centre helps promote wellbeing for children aged 8–11, particularly those facing financial hardship.

Our funding enabled the group to provide essential hygiene items, including toothbrushes, toothpaste, soap, and shampoo. These resources help children develop positive personal care habits and ensure they feel clean, comfortable, and confident when attending sessions.

By offering well-presented hygiene packs that can be used both at home and during activities, this project supports dignity and self-esteem, helping children to fully engage and feel ready to learn, play and socialise—during term time and throughout the school holidays.

# FOOD SOLIDARITY SOUP'ERHEROES

GLASGOW, SCOTLAND

Food Solidarity Soup'erheroes are tackling food insecurity while challenging the stigma and shame often linked to poverty. Through an inclusive, non-judgemental approach, the group promotes sharing, dignity, and solidarity, ensuring everyone is welcomed and supported without discrimination.

Our funding will be used to provide nutritious lunches outside of term time during the Easter, Summer, and October breaks. Children and families will be offered a choice of either a sit-in hot lunch, including soup, a hot main course, fruit and drinks, or a takeaway option with soup, fresh sandwiches, fruit, and drinks. By offering both options, the project aims to respect individual needs and circumstances while ensuring children do not go without food during school holidays.

This support helps families experiencing financial hardship at a time when children can no longer rely on school meals, strengthening food security and reinforcing the message that access to food is a basic human right.

# FAIRFIELD COUNTY PRIMARY SCHOOL PTA

GLAMORGAN, WALES

Fairfield County Primary School PTA is a group of parents and volunteers working closely with the school to support children's wellbeing, development, and sense of community. Through regular collaboration with staff, families and local residents, the PTA helps create opportunities for children to grow, stay active, and feel included.

The PTA organises a wide range of activities, from fundraising events and trips to practical projects that enhance the school environment. Their work supports children aged 3 to 11, ensuring experiences both in and out of school are accessible to all.

Our funding is supporting the purchase of indoor and outdoor play and activity equipment. This project helps children stay active, engaged and connected during breaks from the school routine, while easing pressure on families during the school holidays.

By prioritising health, wellbeing and inclusive play, this project brings children and the wider community together, supporting healthy habits and positive experiences at a time when they matter most.

## ROOTED IN

BRADFORD, ENGLAND

Rooted In supports children and families through a trauma-informed, holistic approach, working to build community and strengthen families by creating safe, positive opportunities for children affected by poverty and inequality.

Asda Foundation funding has enabled the delivery of three weeks of summer holiday provision for primary-aged children, offering structured sessions for up to 35 children each week. The project gave children a safe place to stay active, try new activities and build confidence during the school holidays.

Funding supported daily cooking sessions using fresh ingredients, helping children develop practical skills and learn about healthy eating, alongside a fun “Junior MasterChef”-style challenge. Additional resources provided gardening, outdoor play, sports and creative activities, supporting both physical health and emotional wellbeing.

This project helps reduce holiday-time isolation by giving children access to enriching activities, nutritious food, and supportive role models, while also easing pressure on families during the school holidays.

**Together, we're shaping positive futures for children and young people.**



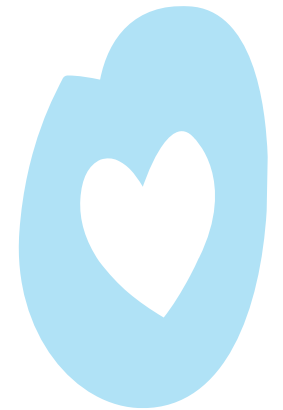
